Use this package based on Hans Christian Andersen's stories as a guide for your lessons. Customise the materials to suit your students' learning needs.

STEP 1

Introduce Hans Christian Andersen with these fun facts.

- Andersen was born in Denmark on 2 April 1805. His birthday is also celebrated together with International Children's Book Day!
- Andersen was an only child, born to a poor cobbler and washerwoman.
- Disney's *Frozen* and *The Little Mermaid* movies were inspired by Andersen's stories!
- Before becoming an author, Andersen was a tailor and an actor!

STEP 2

Introduce fairy tales and the fantasy genre.

- Fairy tales are fantastical stories that contain characters like fairies, goblins, witches, dragons and giants! These stories come from different countries and cultures, and are passed down through storytelling.
- Fairy tales usually start with "Once upon a time, in a land far away...", and have happy endings.
- A fairy tale is a story within the fantasy genre. Overall, fantasy stories are about impossible things like magic and mythical creatures. They often involve heroes, quests, and powerful artefacts.
 - Popular examples: *Harry Potter*, *Beast Quest* and *Rainbow Magic* series.
