

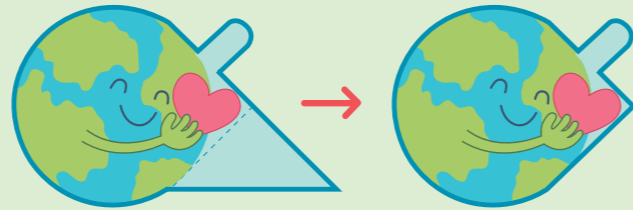
Challenge 1: Corner Bookmark

1 Pop out the template below and write down one way that you will help to save the Earth.



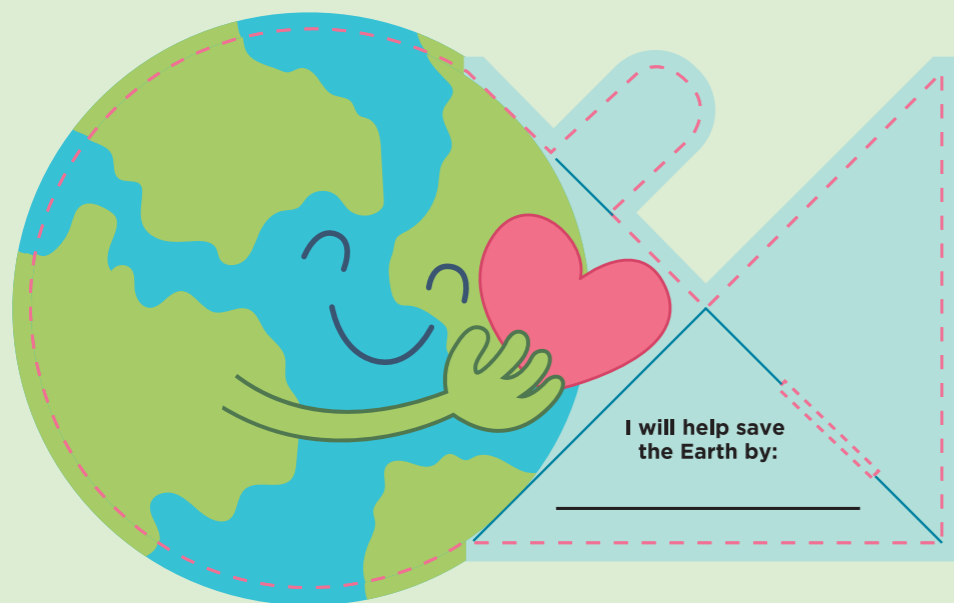
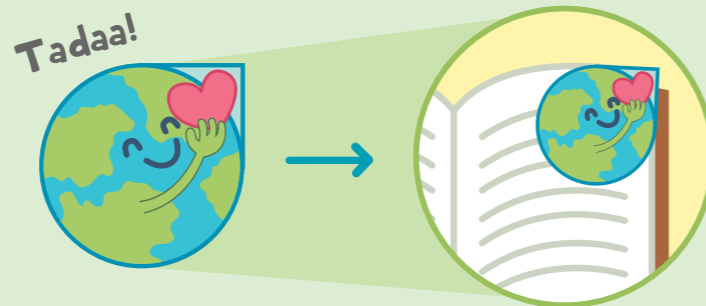
2 Fold the blue lines.
